Dear E-Network Activist,

On June 18th, the House Subcommittee on Financial Services and General Government (FSGG) approved their FY2015 bill. For the first time since 1983, the mandatory language that maintains 6-day mail delivery was not included in the subcommittee's bill. Without this language, the USPS will be permitted to reduce mail delivery to five days per week.

The full committee on Appropriations is scheduled to mark-up the FSGG bill on Wednesday, June 25th at 10:00 a.m. During the full committee mark-up, Rep. Jose Serrano (D-NY) will offer an amendment to put the mandatory 6-day mail delivery language back in to the legislation. We need urgent action!
